General objectives / tasks:

- to share and discuss basic concepts and beliefs underlying our educational / learning work (e.g. global learning, education for sustainable development, education for mother earth right`s, global citizenship education etc., in order to collect deeper information, to identify global gaps etc..
- to concretize the concepts and link them to our work / network without agreeing on “one size for all”, but still have discourse on diverse concepts
- to share and try out successful educational methods and tools related to the topics of the workshops,
- to collect, elaborate / develop methods and contents for all target groups (especial those, we don't meet yet (*important: who are those we don't meet yet? No privileged persons? Or privileged who don't have an intrinsic motivation for change? Who else?*)⇒Learn2Change –modules in order to reach more people / target groups, to come out of the niche.

Results:

- A short report on the basic concepts and beliefs discussed with comments from the group in order to share at the conference. (*The basis could be our vision and mission statement that could be developed further during the conference. Important: discover commonalities, common ground, celebrate diversity – and discuss what this means for the learn2-change-network. Possibly: develop “own Learn2change-method to work on this and bring this into the conference*). Collection of examples for methods and tools (including their aims) that could be applicable in different countries / regional contexts; decision what could be shared in the conference. Can be already existing methods or “new” one.
- Ideas for articles in the publication on basic concepts and beliefs and on best practice; if possible statement of possible own contributions.
- Ideas for themes for webinars, skype-expert interviews; if possible statement of own contributions.
